

## Ministry Leadership Council – Meeting Minutes

### Devotion

- Led by Matt with a review of 1 Timothy and Titus with a discussion on what it means being called for Leadership positions

### Meeting notes:

- **Approval of Meeting Minutes:** Matt led the approval process for both the February MLC meeting minutes and the town hall minutes, confirming approvals from all participants and that the approved minutes be posted to Google Drive.
  - **February MLC Minutes Approval:** Matt confirmed that the February MLC meeting minutes were approved and can be uploaded to Google Drive.
  - **Town Hall Minutes Approval:** approval of the town hall meeting minutes, and were ready for posting.
- **Financial Update (Craig Olsen):**
- Craig provided a financial update, noting a significant increase in general fund giving compared to previous years, and announced an upcoming field measurement for the solar project.
  - **General Fund Giving Status:** Craig reported that general fund giving had increased approximately \$35,000 as of the most recent Sunday for the Q1, indicating sustained financial health for the organization.
  - **Solar Project Field Measurement:** Craig informed that a field measurement for the solar project was scheduled for the following day,
- **2026 Elections Nominating Committee Update:** Matt, provided an update on the nominating committee's progress for the 2026 elections, discussing candidate selection criteria, and outlined the timeline and process for nominations and announcements.

- **Announcement and Nomination Timeline:** The committee decided to delay the public announcement of nominations until after Easter to avoid conflicting with other announcements, scheduling the bulletin announcement and opening of nominations for April 12, after which candidate profiles will be completed.
- **Upcoming Voters Meeting and Call Process:** Jeffrey outlined plans for the upcoming voters meeting on the 29th, which Suzanne will chair in their absence, and lead a discussion about the status for the call process for Rachel Hines.
